Course Objective:

This course has two objectives:

- 1. The student will be able to pass the FCC General License Exam (Element 3), qualifying for the second level FCC Amateur Radio License.
- 2. The student will have sufficient knowledge to operate an amateur radio station on the General Class frequency allocations above 1.8 MHz, with particular focus on HF single sideband operations.


Philosophy:

This is a <u>highly-compressed course</u> that depends on the <u>focus and motivation</u> of the student. <u>Reading assignments</u> <u>must be done in advance of the classroom sessions</u>. The classroom sessions are fast-paced, covering a wide variety of material in a short time. The student is expected to <u>cover Chapters \emptyset – 2 independently</u> – only Q&A and review discussion in class for these.* The use of <u>practice exams</u> is very important for evaluating topic areas that need attention.
